This is the first in a series of biographical sketches of club members. As the first it seems appropriate to begin with our new president for 2022, Susie Mireles.



Congress passed the Coinage Act on April 2, 1792 to establish the first national mint. Philadelphia was chosen as the site of the first mint and the first circulating coins, 11,178 copper cents, were released in March of 1793.
