On March 11th, 14 Club members attended the second hunt in the Antioch section of Buda at the private property of a good friend to the Club. The hunt started at 9 AM and finished up a little after 3 PM because*some hunters* were havng so much fun they had trouble stopping.

As many Members know, the property is mostly covered with trees and grasses with just the occasional clearing, so walking about and swinging a detector can be challenging much of the time. The property is the site of a former church dating back to about 1881 and remnants of the churchfoundation posts still exist. No homes are known to have ever existed on it, but the Antioch section was settled shortly after the Civil War, so there has been considerable history in the area.

As a result, many good finds were found and will probably be displayed in the FOM contest at the April meeting. As usual, our president Andrew probably picked up the most 'stuff' - both trash and treasure.
